
## Collection Days for Household Refuse

Please obey the rules and dispose of refuse correctly

Category	Collection Day (Excluding National Holidays)	Items and Disposal
Combustibles	Weekly	Items 40cm (16in) and smaller are disposed of in specified rubbish bags.
	Tuesdays and Fridays	Food waste, waste paper, plastics which are <u>NOT</u> marked with the symbol, cloth, leather, rubber items etc.
	Weekly	Items sized 40cm-60cm (16in-24in) are disposed of <u>without</u> rubbish bags.
	Fridays	Plastic kerosene tanks, singular (unstacked) clothing boxes, portable coolers, futons etc.
Non- combustibles	Monthly	Glass, porcelain, earthenware, metals etc. are disposed of in transparent bags.
	2nd and 4th Monday	O Gas canisters/spray cans, batteries, fluorescent tubes, lighters, mercury thermometers etc. are disposed of in the <b>orange receptacle</b> provided. Orange Receptacle
Empty cans PET bottles Glass bottles	Monthly	<ul> <li>Empty cans are disposed of in the green cloth</li> <li>receptacle provided.</li> <li>DET betwee one disposed of in the blue cloth meantecle</li> </ul>
	1st and 3rd Monday	<ul> <li>PET bottles are disposed of in the blue cloth receptacle or the green net provided.</li> <li>Glass bottles are disposed of in the orange receptacle provided</li> </ul>
Used paper Beer bottles	Monthly	<ul> <li>Used paper (paper cartons, cardboard, newspapers, magazines, etc.) are tied with paper twine or disposed of in paper bags.</li> <li>Beer bottles and 1.8 litre bottles (transparent brown or</li> </ul>
